Dear Brothers & Sisters:

At our special union meeting on April 29, 2010, the body voted overwhelmingly to ratify the extension of our contract for one year May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011 Term of the contract:

- **Duration:** 1 year May 1st, 2010 to April 30, 2011
- **Wage and Economic Package:** \$ 1.75 increase one year
- **Administrative Dues:** 2% of total package per year will automatically go into dues administration.
- **Employment of Apprentices:** Apprentices shall be employed in a ratio of one apprentice for each (3) plumbers or (3) steamfitters. An apprentice is not permitted on a job until there are at least (3) journeymen on the job.
- **Residential and Commercial Repairs, Replacement and Alterations: (80% rate):** The addition of new fixtures (limit of *THREE*) in tenant spaces when they are near or adjacent to existing plumbing. These fixtures are limited to sinks, lavatories, drinking fountains, kitchenette units and water closets.

The body voted to allocate \$ 1.25 into the following: (1st 6 months):

ZONE I

- a. .50 per hour to local Pensions
- b. .25 per hour toward Health & Welfare
- c. .32 per hour toward Dues Admin.
- d. .13 per hour toward Annuity
- e. .05 per hour toward Education

ZONE II

- .50 per hour to local Pensions
- .25 per hour toward Health & Welfare
- .22 per hour toward Dues Admin.
- .23 per hour toward Annuity
- .05 per hour toward Education


