CALL TO ACTION!!!

Please note that the next MGM meeting will be held on 9/16. This is a community meeting meant for Yonkers residents who are in the trades.

The following is some information with respect to the Meeting:

New York State is preparing to award the remaining downstate commercial casino licenses by the end of this year and Empire City in Yonkers is at serious risk of being left behind. Without strong support from labor and the local community, the economic opportunity this project represents may disappear.

That's why we need your help now.

Local Community Advisory Committees (CACs) are currently reviewing applications and will vote shortly after their **September 16 public hearing**. It's critical that the voices of working people, especially those in Yonkers and Westchester, are heard loud and clear.

Why this matters to labor:

- Empire City's expansion will create over 6,500 union construction jobs and generate nearly 4 million hours of work for the trades.
- In its first year alone, the project is expected to deliver **\$54 million** in revenue to Yonkers and more than **\$17 million** to Westchester County—funds that support vital public services and future job opportunities.
- Without a commercial license, Empire City risks losing its competitive edge—and the entire project, including thousands of jobs and long-term investment, could be lost.
