This program provides apprentices and journeymen the opportunity to earn an Associate of Applied Science degree.

To be eligible for this program, you must be an apprentice or journeyman in a building trades apprentice program approved by the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration, Office of Apprenticeship (USDOL/ETA/OA) or the New York State Department of Labor (NYSDOL).




